AVOID DRINKING WATER ALONG WITH YOUR FOOD

It's common knowledge that drinking eight glasses of water a day is essential for the body to function properly. That's good. But do you know the fact that drinking water along with your food might be damaging your health.

1. It Reduces the saliva in your mouth

Saliva is a mixture that is secreted from many salivary glands in the mouth. It plays a huge role in the pre digestion process. Water dilutes the saliva, which stops the breakdown of food.
