# PLANTING PLANTS



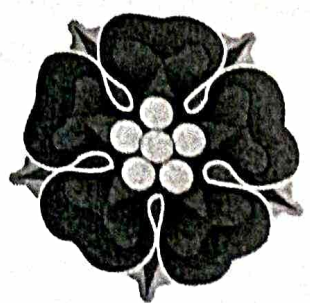
