External reader's services:

Our library is having a collection of 742M.Ed theses, and 55 M.Phil theses. It is a very nice collection kept in orderly manner for easy accessing. There is a separate catalogue for the theses. ID proof has to be shown to the Principal and the Librarian. Only reference is allowed. Photocopying service also can be availed at nominal cost. A nominal fee is charged for this usage. Internet service can also availed by the users. Research scholars are very well benefitted by this facility. The spacious reading room can accommodate the users in a very well manner.

Internet Facility in the Library

There is a broadband connectivity in 16 computers connected with LAN. The speed of the connection is also very good. Wi-Fi facility is also available. Printing facility is available at nominal cost. Students can make use of the N-list online journals. Readers are getting the up-to-date knowledge through internet facility. Teachers get their required information through internet facility.

Book Bank Facility

Our library is having the book bank facility. Students who want to avail the book bank facility has to approach the Librarian and can get the use of the facility. This facility is providing the books for the economically backward

students. The books are provided for the students for the academic year as per the availability of the no of books. The backward and needy students get the whole set of books for an academic year. A large no of students are benefitted by this scheme.
