The Media Club 'Drishti' collaborated with the Women's Cell in telecasting short films on Women Empowerment to strengthen gender morale.

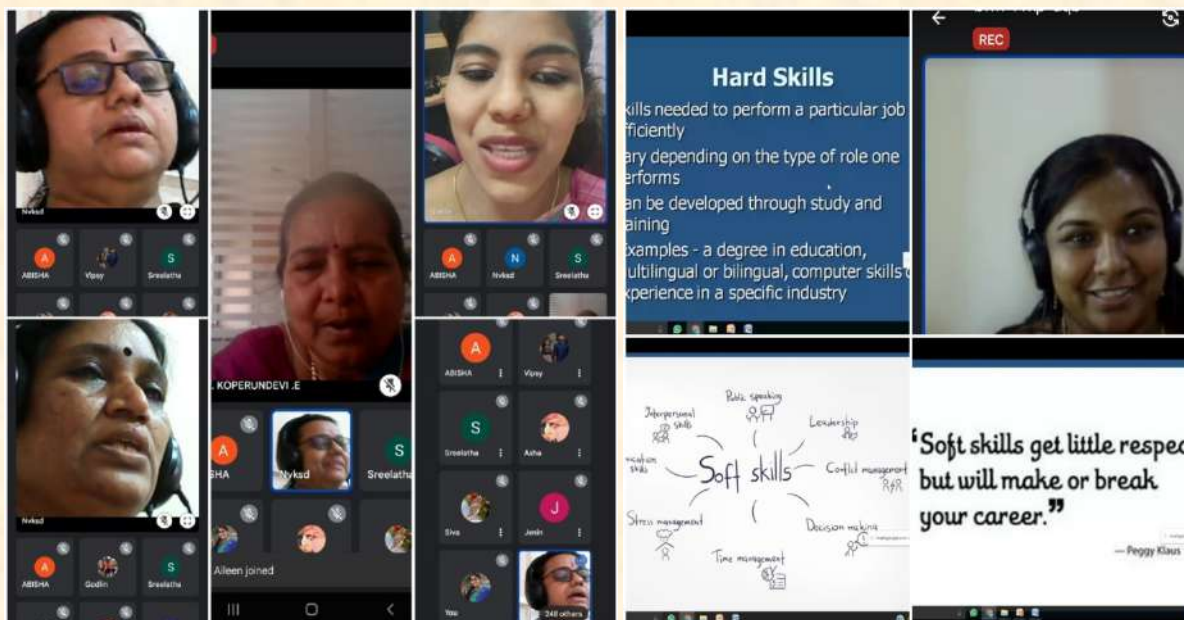
